



Release Notes for DxO Optics Pro 5.1 Mac **PUBLIC BETA**

Features that are missing from the BETA but that will be in the final release:

- Adobe Photoshop® Import Plug-In.
- DxO Optics Pro plug-in for Adobe Lightroom®.
- DxO Optics Pro export to Adobe Lightroom plug-in.
- DxO Optics Pro export to Flickr® plug-in.
- Adobe Lightroom External Editor feature.
- DxO Optics Pro activation.
- DxO FilmPack activation.
- « Check for Updates » feature.
- DxO Module installer not integrated into the application.
- Export Image for ICC profile creation.
- Shadow/Highlight clipping indication.
- Automatic processor load adjustment.
- « Reset » option for perspective correction in the 'Prepare' tab.
- Crop feature.
- Grid overlay feature.
- Image information overlay feature.
- Tooltips.
- Keyboard shortcuts.
- Localization (the BETA is only in english).
- The BETA cannot read DNG files from the Samsung GX20 or Pentax K10D).
- Import/export of v5 presets.
- Import of v4 presets.
- Import of v4 projects.

Changes between version 4 and version 5

- The slideshow feature has been removed.
- Import/Export of 'sidecar' files is not possible.
- Import of version 3 'sidecars' is not possible.

Known bugs in DxO Optics Pro v5.1 Macintosh **PUBLIC BETA**

- Repeated use of the 'Process Now' feature leads to excessive disk usage and followed by a system crash.
- Application sometimes freezes during an image refresh.
- The navigation palette does not display rotated images correctly.
- DNG output has an incorrect pink cast and is overexposed.
- When creating an output format, desired image size information is not taken into account.
- In the 'Prepare' tab, the zoom level 'Fit' leads to an off center image.
- Incorrect sharpness previews between 'Before' and 'After' images in the 'Prepare' tab at certain magnifications.
- The screen ICC profile is not applied to the 'Before' image.
- Distortion correction applies even if the feature has been turned off (for a zoom level of 100% or more).
- Application crashes when visualizing a stack after a preset has been applied.

- The 'hand' cursor of the navigation palette remains active even when the palette is minimized.
- Renaming a preset modifies the state of the preset (Save and Discard buttons inactive)
- Application slows down when loading big folder.
- Adding an image from one project into the project window does not carry across the settings for that image.
- Impossible to drag and drop into the project window from the 'Prepare' content pane or from the Finder.
- The menu item « Add to stack » is missing.
- No image displayed in the « Move » palette.
- Corrected images are sometimes incorrectly saved into the database.
- Display of image information is missing in the case where a Module ambiguity situation is detected.
- The 'OK' confirmation button is inactive when removing images from the Project Window.
- Filtering feature is missing in the content pane of the 'Prepare' tab.
- Adjusting zoom level with the mouse wheel does not always work correctly.
- If having selected several images in the 'Detail'(List) mode, one switches to the icon mode, the selection is lost.
- Occasional display issues in the customizable « My Palette » palette.
- Using the 'Exposure compensation' slider, sets the exposure drop down menu to 'off' (however the cursor value is applied)
- The image is sometimes not properly centered after a zoom.
- Working with stacks in the Project window occasionally leads to a crash.
- Color rendering sometimes reverts to 'As Shot' unexpectedly.
- It is not possible to delete a color point in the multi-color balance feature.
- On import, no persistence of the open/closed state of folders when in detail mode.
- Cannot add author/copyright information in edited presets.
- No refresh of the Project window when using the 'undo' feature.
- Incorrect image refresh when using the 'Tone Curve' feature.
- Output images not rotated.
- Incorrect processing of chromatic aberrations on black & white images.
- The 'recent projects' list is empty.
- When working with DxO Optics Pro v5.1 Mac PUBLIC BETA, all three Folder views usually associated with Mac OSX are available. Folder content can be displayed as icons, lists or columns. However a bug greatly slows down display in the 'column' mode making it unworkable certain tasks (multi-image selection for example).
- Image display is incorrect or 'blacked out' with certain video cards that are in particular present in some older model Power PC based Macintosh computers. Disabling GPU support in the 'Preferences', corrects the problem.
